

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON APRIL 7, 2015.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Tom Heidenwirth with members Rex Ackerman and Rusty Eddy present. Also present were Emergency Management Coordinator Mitch Nordmeyer, Sheriff Jason Johnson, Engineer John Riherd, Gordy Ballhagen and Larry Bass, New Hartford, Iowa and Fern Myers, Allison, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with New Hartford City Council members Larry Bass and Gordy Ballhagen concerning the road condition of an extension of Highway 57 going north into New Hartford. Also present was Mira Schmitt-Cash, Mid-America Publishing. Engineer Riherd will give the city a cost estimate of needed repairs and the City of New Hartford will make available to Engineer the existing plan for the road work already completed north of the Railroad tracks. It was determined that an independent opinion of ownership of the road is necessary.

Moved by Eddy, second by Ackerman to approve Iowa DOT FY2016 Secondary Road Budget. Motion carried.

Moved by Ackerman, second by Eddy to approve 5-Year Secondary Road Construction Program. Motion carried.

Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Ackerman to authorize Chair to execute contract between the Board of Supervisors and the Iowa Department of Public Health for Medicolegal Death Investigator Training for Tammy Fleshner. Motion carried.

Board reviewed the Quarterly Reports of Auditor and Sheriff and ordered placed on file.

Board approved claims as submitted.
