The application and maintenance of chemicals to control dust on crushed rock surfaced roads shall be by permit only and in accordance with the following conditions. By signing, applicant understands and agrees to abide by the following conditions:

1. This permit is valid from May 14, 2018 to October 15, 2018 so areas can be worked before and after winter. The 1<sup>st</sup> application date is dependent on road conditions.
2. The applicant or contractor applying a dust control agent shall notify the County Engineer's Office 5 days in advance of each application so the roadway may be properly shaped prior to application.
3. Materials approved for use on roads to control dust are Calcium Chloride, Magnesium Chloride, Lignin Sulfonate, or soy-oil based products. **Used motor oil is not approved.**
4. The applicant shall identify the dust control area with flags available at the County Engineer's Office. The applicant shall be responsible for flags being maintained on all sides throughout the dust control period. Unmarked areas may inadvertently be rocked and/or bladed if not properly marked.
5. The owner shall maintain the treated area and repair any roughness that may develop.
6. The County reserves the right to rework the treated areas and maintain them as loose granular surfaces without notice if the permit applicant fails to maintain the treated area in an acceptable condition. Defects include, but are not limited to: potholes, ruts, and rough surfaces that would cause an unsafe surface for vehicular traffic.
