

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON JULY 19, 2016.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Rusty Eddy with members Rex Ackerman and Tom Heidenwirth present. Also present were Engineer John Riherd and Jenn Miller, Shell Rock, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Ackerman to accept the recommendation of the Engineer and approve the following:

**RESOLUTION #867
TEMPORARY STOP SIGNS**

WHEREAS, The Butler County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Section 321.255 of the Code of Iowa, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation to erect traffic control devices, and

WHEREAS, a bridge replacement project, BROS-3102(602)--60-12, located on C13 (110th Street) at the east corporate limits of Greene requires County Route C13 to be detoured, and

WHEREAS, a detour route has been established and signed for thru traffic, and

WHEREAS, motorists failing to follow the designated detour route will likely cause an increase in traffic on surrounding local roads, and

WHEREAS, traffic safety would be better served if a stop condition was established for Sandhill Road at its intersection with 120th Street for traffic approaching the intersection from the south, and

WHEREAS, traffic safety would be better served if a stop condition was established for Oak Avenue at its intersection with 120th Street for traffic approaching the intersection from the north, and

WHEREAS, traffic safety would be better served if a stop condition was established for Oak Avenue at its intersection with 120th Street for traffic approaching the intersection from the south, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Butler County Board of Supervisors that a stop condition be established for Sandhill Road at 120th Street and that a stop condition be established for Oak Avenue at 120th Street for the duration of Project BROS-3102(602)--60-12 and that the proper signs be erected, as determined by the County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that once the temporary traffic control is no longer warranted, as determined by the County Engineer, the temporary stop sign shall be removed without further action of this board.
