

**MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON APRIL 6, 2010.**

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Ken Oldenburger with members John Zimmerman and Karl Nelson present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with Shawna Lebeck, Community Coordinator, to proclaim the month of April as Child Abuse Prevention Month.

**Pinwheels for Prevention 2010 Child Abuse Prevention Month**  
**“Protecting Children is Everyone’s Business”**

Whereas, Iowa’s Children are one of the most precious resources in our state and provide the hope for a brighter tomorrow in Iowa;

Whereas, protecting children is everyone’s business and we can promote and support safe, healthy families in our community through partnering to protect children;

Whereas, child abuse is a community issue and finding solutions depends on involvement and partnerships among people throughout the community;

Whereas, effective child abuse prevention succeeds because of partnerships created between parents, practitioners, schools, faith communities, health care organizations, law enforcement agencies, community leaders, politicians, and the business community;

Whereas, all citizens need to be more aware of child abuse and neglect and its prevention within the community, and be involved in supporting parents to raise their children in a safe, nurturing society;

Whereas, public awareness regarding child abuse and neglect is encouraged by Prevent Child Abuse Iowa, Together 4 Families and Butler County Visions of Well-Being.

Therefore, I, Ken Oldenburger, Butler County Board of Supervisors Chairperson, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2010, as Child Abuse Prevention month in Butler County and urge all citizens, community agencies, religious organizations, medical facilities, and businesses to partner in efforts to prevent child abuse and neglect, thereby strengthening the communities in which we live.

Board met with Jim Miller to hear his report of dead cows being found in the ditch near his home at 21752 Hickory Avenue. He stated he is very concerned about his water quality. The Board acknowledged his concerns, and recommended he contact the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and the Iowa Department of Agriculture.

Board met with County Engineer John Riherd for the following:

- 1) After review, it was moved by Nelson, second by Zimmerman to approve the Iowa Department of Transportation FY11 Secondary Road Construction Program and Budget. Motion carried.

Time set for a Public Hearing to consider a Resolution Adopting a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for Butler County. Present were County Engineer John Riherd and David Smesrud, Iowa Northland Regional Council of Governments Community Planner. No written or oral comments were received. Smesrud updated the Board on progress of cities located within the County in their adoption of the Plan. Upon the close of the Public Hearing, it was moved by Zimmerman, second by Nelson to approve said Resolution as follows:

**RESOLUTION NO. 691**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, OF BUTLER COUNTY, IOWA, ADOPTING A MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR BUTLER COUNTY.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa has authorized the development of a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan for the Butler County; and

WHEREAS, Butler County, Iowa has received funding through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee of the Butler County has participated in the formulation of said Plan; and has recommended the adoption of said Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing has been held in the County Courthouse for the purpose of obtaining citizen input on the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa herewith adopts the Butler County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, incorporating into the Plan citizen comment and future FEMA and IHSEMD recommendations.

Board continued meeting with County Engineer John Riherd for the following:

2) After review, it was moved by Zimmerman, second by Nelson to approve an Amendment to the Iowa Department of Transportation FY10 Secondary Road Budget. Motion carried.

3) Riherd reviewed a number of County Policies relating to ditch cleaning and shared with the Board a few recent problems that have arisen. Existing policies reviewed included those concerning ditches, tile outlets, septic tank outlets, and excessive soil loss. Riherd stated he planned to develop a new "Work in the Right of Way" policy which would combine the existing policies and bring it back to the Board for consideration. He indicated he would also like to develop a "Work in the Right of Way" permit.

Treasurer Louise Squires was unavailable.

Board considered an Application by Tack-Barnett American Legion Post 268 for a Class A Liquor License. Moved by Nelson, second by Zimmerman to approve same. Motion carried.

Board considered Amendment #1 to the SSBG County Contract between Butler County and the Iowa Department of Human Services. Moved by Nelson, second by Zimmerman to approve same. Motion carried.

Jan Loyson, Iowa Department of Economic Development, was unavailable.

Board met with Bill Croell, Croell Redi-Mix, to discuss with him their recent request for removal of culverts placed over an existing low water crossing located on Newell Avenue over the Johnson Creek in Sections 19 & 20 of Albion Township.

Also present were Dennis Mulder, David Freeseaman, Robert Kolder, Tim Kolder, Prentice Karsjens, and Joe Wallbaum.

Croell stated he had followed the proper procedure by having a plan approved by County Engineer Riherd and had spent a considerable amount of money to now be told he has to remove the improvements.

Riherd stated that Croell had in fact received permission for the improvements and felt, due to that fact, that Butler County Secondary Roads should remove the improvements at their expense. After removal, the original Missouri Crossing is to remain in place until such time that the Board finds a different structure necessary and approves proposed changes.

Croell admitted that the improvements had negatively impacted neighboring lands and agreed that removing them would be the right thing to do. He expressed appreciation of Secondary Roads offer of removal, but inquired as to whether or not he could be reimbursed for any of his expenses. Riherd indicated that his request for reimbursement would be considered. Riherd further indicated that every attempt would be made to have the improvements removed by May 31, 2010.

Board reviewed Quarterly Reports of the Auditor and Sheriff and ordered placed on file.
