

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON MARCH 1 2011.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Karl Nelson with members Ken Oldenburger and Tom Heidenwirth present. Also present was Jane Stauffer, Greene, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with Public Health Director Jennifer Becker.

1) Board reviewed Agreement Regarding Public Health Annual Sub-Fund in which County agrees to make a \$125,000 allocation to the Public Health Sub-Fund for Fiscal Year 2012. Moved by Oldenburger, second by Heidenwirth to approve same. Motion carried.

2) It was then moved by Heidenwirth, second by Nelson to adopt Resolution No. 494-FY12 authorizing the Auditor to transfer said \$125,000 from General Basic Fund to Public Health Sub-Fund for Fiscal Year 2012 as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 494-FY12

WHEREAS, the Butler County Board of Supervisors and the Butler County Board of Health have reached an agreement regarding the Public Health Annual Sub-Fund, and

WHEREAS, such agreement establishes an annual allocation of funds be transferred from the General Basic Fund to the Public Health Sub-Fund, and

WHEREAS, that the amount of said annual allocation shall be determined annually,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Butler County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Auditor to transfer \$125,000.00 from the General Basic Fund into the Public Health Sub-Fund. Said transfer shall be for Fiscal Year 2012 and shall be made as soon after the beginning of the new fiscal year as possible.

WHEREUPON the Resolution was declared duly adopted this 1st day of March, 2011.

3) Becker explained the need for the Board of Supervisors to rescind Butler County Ordinances Title V, No. 9 – Health Regulations of Butler County by Creation of Septic Contractor Licensing & Title V, No. 10 – Private Water Well Construction to allow Board of Health to adopt same. Becker indicated that County Attorney Greg Lievens recommended the Board of Health adopt said Ordinances in their present form and after that action has been taken, the Butler County Board of Supervisors could proceed with rescinding them. The Board asked Becker to proceed with the proper steps to complete the adoption by the Board of Health.

Board acknowledged Original Manure Management Plan for Unpermitted Site for Rod Ballhagen, and acknowledged Manure Management Plan Annual Updates for Butler Finisher Farm; Riverton Site 1; Norwood Site; Kuper Finisher Farm; Roose South Finisher Farm; RB Winkowitsch Finisher Farm; Brad Finisher Farm; McCandless #2 Finisher Farm; and Quail Finisher Farm.

After review of a Services Agreement with amt2 for website services, it was moved by Oldenburger, second by Heidenwirth to approve said Agreement. Motion carried.

Board considered Economic Development Financial Assistance Contract by Unverferth Manufacturing Company, Inc., Butler County, and the Iowa Dept. of Economic Development. Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Oldenburger to approve same. Motion carried.

John Riherd was present.

Board held a Public Hearing on a proposed Ordinance VI No. 10 Providing For the Special Valuation of Wind Energy Conversion Property. Jane Stauffer, Greene, Iowa, was present. Also present was Butler County Assessor Deb McWhirter. Auditor Holly A. Fokkena indicated she had received no oral or written comments. Stauffer had several questions on how this would affect single wind generators on private acreages. McWhirter indicated this ordinance was directed more to wind farms and larger operations. She further indicated she would need to perform more research on assessing small single units. Upon the close of the Public Hearing, it was moved by Heidenwirth, second by Oldenburger to approve said Ordinance on its first reading as follows:

BUTLER COUNTY ORDINANCE VI, No. 10

Title: Assessment of Wind Energy Conversion Property

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the special valuation of wind energy conversion property pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 427B.26.

SECTION 2. Definitions. For use in this ordinance, certain terms and words used herein shall be interpreted or defined as follows:

- (a) "NET ACQUISITION COST" means the cost of the property including all foundations and installation cost less any excess cost adjustment.
- (b) "WIND ENERGY CONVERSION PROPERTY" means the entire wind plant including, but not limited to, a wind charger, windmill, wind turbine, tower and electrical equipment, pad mount transformers, power lines and substation.

SECTION 3. Authority to Establish. The Board of Supervisors is authorized, pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 427B.26 to provide by ordinance for special valuation of wind energy conversion property as provided in Section 4.

SECTION 4. Establishment. Pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 427B.26, a special valuation of wind energy conversion property is allowed in lieu of the valuation assessment provisions in Iowa Code Chapter 441.21(8)(b) and (c), and Iowa Code Chapters 428.24 and 428.29. The special valuation shall only apply to wind energy conversion property first assessed on or after January 1, 1994, and on or after the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Amount of Valuation. Wind energy conversion property first assessed on or after the effective date of the ordinance shall be valued by the County Assessor for property tax purposes as follows:

- (a) For the first assessment year, at zero percent (0%) of the net acquisition cost.
- (b) For the second through sixth assessment years, at a percent of the net acquisition cost which rate increases by five percent (5%) each assessment year.
- (c) For the seventh and succeeding assessment years, at thirty percent (30%) of the net acquisition cost.

SECTION 6. Declaration of Special Valuation. The taxpayer shall file with the county assessor by February 1st of the assessment year in which the wind energy conversion property is first assessed for property tax purposes, a declaration of intent to have the property assessed at the value determined under Section 5 in lieu of the valuation assessment provisions in Iowa Code Chapter 441.21(9)(b) and (c), and Iowa Code Chapters 428.24 and 428.29.

SECTION 7. Reporting Requirements. The following reports shall be filed annually with the County Assessor by the taxpayer; in the first year, with the declaration of intent as prescribed in Section 6; and by February 1st of each year thereafter:

- (a) Copy of asset ledger sheet to IRS;
- (b) Engineering breakdown of component parts;
- (c) Tower numbering system;
- (d) Name of contact person, phone number, FAX number, and mailing address;
- (e) Report of all leased equipment, the name(s) of the company(s) it is leased from, and the agreement between the lessor and lessee regarding who is responsible for the property tax on the leased equipment.

SECTION 8. Repeal of Special Valuation. If in the opinion of the Board of Supervisors continuation of the special valuation provided under Section 4 ceases to be of benefit to the county, the Board of Supervisors may repeal the ordinance. Property specially valued under Section 4 prior to repeal of the ordinance shall continue to be valued under Section 4 until the end of the nineteenth (19th) assessment year following the assessment year in which the property was first assessed.

SECTION 9. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10. Severability Clause. If any section, provision or other part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, said adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or other part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
